NEW CPE AUDIT POLICY

Effective with the 2016 CPE audit (audit of courses submitted for the 2017 license renewal), those CPAs who fail a CPE audit will have to make up the hours disallowed in the audit in addition to paying a fine. For several years the audits have resulted in fines only but the Board believes that the profession and public is better served by having CPAs who fail to meet the CPE standards make up the hours that were either not taken or disallowed.

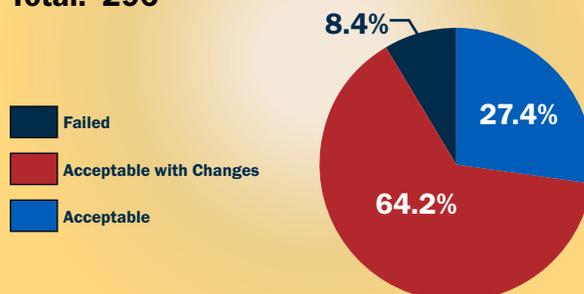

ASBPA Ethics Course Required Only Once Every Three Years

Beginning in 2015 Arkansas CPAs (active) were required to take a one hour ethics course that covered rules and statutes of the Arkansas State Board of Public Accountancy. This course only has to be taken once every three years.

The Board extends its congratulations for these appointments – to our knowledge Mike is the first person from Arkansas to serve on the AICPA Board of Examiners in several decades and possibly the first ever from Arkansas to serve.

AUGUST BOARD DISCIPLINARY CASES

The following cases were closed at the August 19, 2016 Board Meeting:

1. C13-024 – A non CPA was discovered holding out under Accountants - Certified Public in the Yellow pages. The owner is now deceased and it appears the firm has gone out of business. The case was closed with no further action taken.
2. C14-177 – A licensee failed to renew their individual Arkansas CPA license for 2016. A hearing was held June 3, 2016 and the license was revoked.
3. C15-028 – An out-of-state CPA was discovered holding out as a CPA in Arkansas. The individual subsequently moved back out of state. The case was closed with no further action taken.
4. C15-056 – A firm licensee failed to renew their firm license for 2015. A hearing was held June 3, 2016 and the firm license was revoked.
5. C15-083 – The Board received notice that a licensee had been sanctioned by the PCAOB. The licensee is a partner in an out of state firm. A compliance statement requiring timely renewal for next three (3) years has been signed and \$710 in renewal / late fees / penalties collected.

2. C16-038 – A licensee failed to renew their individual Arkansas CPA license for 2016, misstated 3 different Quality Review survey responses, and failed to acknowledge attest work performed for 8 annual renewals. A hearing was held on September 30, 2016 and the license was revoked.
3. C16-065 – A licensee failed to renew their license and became lapsed April 1, 2016. The licensee elected to take retired status and the case was closed.

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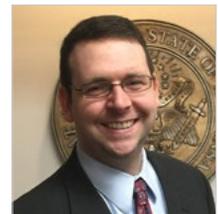
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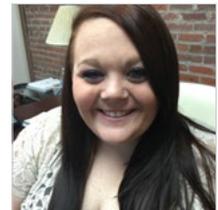
